

## Canadian Immunization Research Network Trainee Document

As a recipient of the Canadian Immunization Research Network (CIRN) trainee scholarship you are expected to follow the points listed below

- Attend in the CIRN and CCfV Education Series, bi-weekly 1-hour seminars (typically held on the second and fourth Thursday of every month)
  - Act as moderator for the second seminar at least once per year (could be asked to moderate more, depending on number of trainees funded at the time)
  - Engage in the presentation by asking questions and/or offering commentary
- Present at the CCfV Education Seminar once per year (if you have received funding for two years)
- You will be invited to attend the CIRN Annual General Meeting and expected to present your research
- Disseminate your research results through publications, presentations, conferences, workshops, seminars and/or the media and community by following the CIRN publication policy
  - When presenting or publishing in any print or electronic materials (posters/videos) should be acknowledged with the CIRN logo
  - For as verbal correspondence (interviews/podcasts) CIRN should be acknowledge/mentioned
- Provide a progress report after your first year of funding (if funded two years) and final report when finished your first (if you're a masters trainee) or second year (if you're a PhD/Post Doc trainee)
